TUSCANY AT TAMPA PALMS

Tuscany is an HOA-managed, deed-restricted community. It is **NOT** a maintenance-free community in that homeowners must maintain their property by performing these routine maintenance requirements: roof cleaning/repairs, cleaning/painting of exterior, driveway, and landscaped beds.

Your realtor should have provided you with a copy of the Tuscany deed restrictions, declaration of covenants, and bylaws <u>prior</u> to your decision to purchase a home in Tuscany. Owners and tenants of rental properties are also expected to abide by the deed restrictions of this community. Be aware that multiple violation notifications from the twice monthly inspections without satisfactory and timely resolution could result in the matter being referred to an attorney for further legal action. Don't let matters get to this stage; read, know, and abide by Tuscany's deed restrictions. Keep our neighborhood an appealing community for everyone to enjoy.

Glacier National Park is located in Montana and is a hiker's paradise with over 700 miles of trails. One of the few remaining glaciers in North America is in Glacier National Park. Visitors can also enjoy forests, alpine meadows, rugged mountains, and spectacular lakes.

A MESSAGE FROM THE HOA BOARD - ILLEGAL PARKING

According to the Tuscany at Tampa Palms Owners Association Use Restrictions and Rules, no vehicle is permitted to be parked so that it blocks any portion of a sidewalk at any time. Any vehicle parked in violation of this rule is subject to being towed, at the expense of the owner, 24/7.

ARTICLE V

USE RESTRICTIONS AND RULES

Section 4. **Parking and Garages** - Parking shall be permitted only in the garage or in the driveway serving each Unit and then subject to such reasonable rules and regulations as the Board of Directors may adopt. No vehicles may be parked on paved streets overnight. Overnight parking is defined as parking between the hours of midnight and 6 a.m. No vehicle is permitted to be parked so that it blocks any portion of a sidewalk. No parking is permitted on grass. Temporary parking on the street is permitted between 6 A.M. and midnight, but any vehicle which creates a blockage of the road that impedes passage by an emergency vehicle will be considered to be illegally parked. All vehicles parked in violation of this Section or of any Board-made rules and regulations will be subject to being towed, at the expense of the owner of the vehicle.



HILLSBOROUGH CO. SOLID WASTE COLLECTION & DISPOSAL

All homeowners should have received the "green card" notice in the mail recently announcing a public hearing on **August 4**th concerning the proposed solid waste assessment for 2022, which will increase. Property owners who wish to speak in person at the hearing must complete the Public Hearing Comment Form found at **HillsboroughCounty.org/SpeakUp**. The completed form must be submitted before 8:30 am on August 4th. Up to 3 minutes will be allowed for each speaker. TRASH & RECYCLE BINS

Bins must be kept inside garages except on pickup days (Mondays & Thursdays). Bins should be placed curbside on Sunday and Wednesday evenings, then returned to garages after pickup on Monday and Thursday. Bins are not to be left curbside or in driveways.



YARD WASTE

Thursday is pickup day for yard waste. Place bins, bags, tree limbs, etc., curbside on Thursday mornings.
